You have met all requirements of the World Academy of Cosmetic Surgery for Board Certification in the category "General Aesthetic Surgery".

An average 50 CME Category 1 credits in Cosmetic Surgery per year for the six (6) years preceding your application and at least **300 CME credits** in cosmetic surgery in the six years prior to application.

You have submitted typed case logs documenting at least 200 cosmetic procedures performed in the year prior to application with typed operative reports, with clearly labeled publication quality before and after photographs.

Having successfully completed the Board Examination (carried out by the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery) you are awarded a certificate that will be valid for ten (10) years. Diplomates of the World Academy of Cosmetic Surgery must be re-examined every ten (10) years to maintain certification.
